

# Are you ready for the 1 January EBIS transition?

## 1 EBIS Members

EBIS Members who do not have access to the SIRE programme are encouraged to apply through the OCIMF website at <https://register.ocimf-sire.org/>.

## 2 Submitting Companies

BIQ bookings before 1st January 2021 to be made using SIRE BIQ-Europe questionnaire, helpdesk can change manually to SIRE BIQ-EBIS9 format on 2nd January 2021 with key information.

## 3 Submitting Companies and Programme Recipients

Ready to receive BIQ-EBIS9 reports and revised BPQ-Europe vessel information.

## 4 New European SIRE Cat 3 Inspectors

- All SIRE Inspectors should ensure they have downloaded the latest SIRE inspection editor once release has been communicated.
- Newly accredited SIRE Cat 3 Inspectors should ensure their SIRE accounts are fully active.

## 5 Vessel Operator

- Ensure they are registered within SIRE, their fleet is accurate in the database, and their BPQ-Europe is either manually populated or has been automatically imported.
- New online crew matrix reports should be created in advance of inspections starting in January 2021.
- Desktop SIRE BPQ editor, download and install the latest version in January 2021. No action is required if using the online SIRE editor.
